Campaign to promote the Del Rio and Acuña Ports of Entry starts



To increase commercial crossings on the border of Acuña, Coahuila and Del Rio, Texas that will result in economic benefits for both cities, the Union of Business Organizations of Acuña, federal, state and municipal authorities of both communities officially started “*The Right Way*” campaign that will publicize the competitive advantages of utilizing the customs’ facilities and ports of entries of the Acuna-Del Rio Border Crossing.

In press conferences, which were held in the city of Acuña and later in Del Rio, Texas, the coordinator of the working group for the promotion of ports of entry and president of CANACINTRA-Acuna, Mr. Trinidad Herrera Fernandez, explained the background that motivated this project where he highlighted new and modern port of entry facilities in the two cities, as well as the privileged geographic location and security of this part of the border between Mexico and the United States.

For this campaign, promotional and advertising tools were designed. The first stage of the campaign started with twenty-seven visits to industries in the southeast region of Coahuila (Saltillo, Ramos Arizpe, Derramadero).
